Subject: Drive-by Communion During the Pandemic

Friends—

The staff and Board of First Christian Church at White Hall have closely monitored all of the relevant reports from local and national health officials. We are committed both to supporting the good health decisions of our community both in the church and beyond as well as continuing to provide whatever spiritual services may be appropriate and safe.

Beginning this Sunday, March 22, we will not be meeting as a church community on Sunday morning as we normally do. We know this is not only inconvenient but possibly frustrating. In lieu of communal worship, we will be offering a much safer alternative. Beginning this Sunday, until the crisis is averted, Pastor Kevin will be at the church on Sunday mornings beginning at 9:00 a.m. lasting through 11:00 a.m. to serve communion to all who come through the church portico. You will be given self-contained communion kits. Pastor Kevin, while remaining outside your vehicle, will lead you through a brief communion service in your car and pray over you and with you. Though brief, it is our desire to provide some level of spiritual service to any who choose to do so in the safety of their own vehicle.

For those who may be ill or choose to remain safely at home, please stay home, your well-being is of utmost importance to us. We are currently exploring ways to get an actual sermon out over the internet. Please be patient as this may take as much as two weeks.
